

THE PRATT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET TUESDAY, JANUARY 3, 2017 AT 4:00 P.M. IN THE COMMISSION ROOM, COURTHOUSE, WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: JOE REYNOLDS, DAVID L. WARD AND GLENNA L. BORHO. ALSO PRESENT WERE ROBERT SCHMISSEUR, COUNTY COUNSELOR, GALE ROSE, PRATT TRIBUNE REPORTER, SHERRY KRUSE, COUNTY CLERK AND SUE DEWEESE.

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

NANCY SMITH, COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK COORDINATOR, REPORTED ON COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK HOURS; 61 PEOPLE COMPLETED 3148.5 HOURS DURING 2016; WORKSITES IN THE COUNTY INCLUDED THE PRATT COUNTY COURTHOUSE, LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER, RSVP PROGRAM, PRATT COUNTY FOOD BANK, COMMODITY DISTRIBUTIONS, PRATT AREA HUMANE SOCIETY, PRATT AREA RECYCLING CENTER, PRATT COUNTY LAKE, THE HOPE CENTER, PRATT HEALTH FOUNDATION, PRAIRIELAND FOODS, SOUTHWIND HOSPICE THRIFT SHOP, RED CROSS, PASS IT FORWARD MINISTRIES, SACRED HEART, LEMON PARK LIGHTS AND THE SALVATION ARMY; SOME CLIENTS DID WORK OUTSIDE PRATT COUNTY; SOME CLIENTS WORKED OFF FINES WHICH THE COURT DETERMINES THE AMOUNT OF HOURS; THERE ARE CURRENTLY 62 OPEN COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK FILES WHICH INCLUDE THE PRATT COUNTY ATTORNEY WITH 21 OPEN FILES; SOUTH CENTRAL COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS 27 OPEN FILES; COURT SERVICES 14 OPEN FILES; WORKERS WILL BE TAKING DOWN CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS AT THE COURTHOUSE TOMORROW AND WILL WORK SATURDAY, JANUARY 7<sup>TH</sup> HELPING TAKE DOWN LEMON PARK LIGHTS.
