

THE PRATT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET MONDAY, MARCH 13, 2017 AT 4:00 P.M. IN THE COMMISSION ROOM, COURTHOUSE, WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: DAVID L. WARD, GLENNA L. BORHO AND JOE R. REYNOLDS. ALSO PRESENT WERE ROBERT SCHMISSEUR, COUNTY COUNSELOR, GALE ROSE, PRATT TRIBUNE REPORTER AND SHERRY KRUSE, COUNTY CLERK.

DOUG FREUND, ROAD AND BRIDGE DIRECTOR, SUBMITTED A ROAD CROSSING PERMIT FOR FARMA INC., TOM SCHNITTKER, PRATT, KS TO RUN ELECTRICAL LINE FOR WATER WELL IN THE NE4 4-26-11.

DARCIE VAN DER VYVER, HEALTH DIRECTOR, PRESENTED THE LOCATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PRATT COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND USD 382 TO USE THEIR FACILITIES IN THE EVENT OF A DISASTER/MEDICAL EMERGENCY; COMMISSIONER REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT WITH USD 382 TO USE THEIR FACILITIES IN CASE OF A DISASTER/MEDICAL EMERGENCY. COMMISSIONER BORHO SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION CARRIED 3-0. DARCIE REPORTED THEY HAVE RECEIVED THE \$2500 REBATE ON THE VACCINE REFRIGERATOR; WEBINARS ON THE NEW ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORDS PROGRAM WILL START ON MARCH 20, 2017 AND GO LIVE IN JUNE; HAD A SMALL GAS LEAK IN THE BUILDING AND THAT HAS BEEN REPAIRED; PLUMBING ISSUE ON THE MAIN FLOOR CAUSED DAMAGE TO THE CEILING IN THE BASEMENT.

TIM BRANSCOM, EMERGENCY MANAGER/ZONING ADMINISTRATOR, SAID THE ANNUAL STORM SPOTTER MEETING IS WEDNESDAY, MARCH 15, 2017 AT 7:00 P.M. AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER; LEAVING FOR WASHINGTON DC NEXT MONDAY; DISCUSSED THE TV RECEPTION ISSUE IN THE AREA OF THE WIND FARM ; THERE ARE SIX PEOPLE TOTAL BETWEEN KINGMAN AND PRATT COUNTY WITH PROBLEMS; HOMES AFFECTED HAVE THE OLD STYLE ANTENNAS; DAVID GILL, NEXTERA, SAID THEY WILL PROVIDE A TWO YEAR RENEWABLE CONTRACT WHILE NEXTERA FIGURES OUT THE PROBLEM; THE COUNTY IS NOT REALLY INVOLVED; THIS IS BETWEEN THE RESIDENTS AND NEXTERA; NO PLANNING BOARD MEETING THIS MONTH.

ROBERT TORRES, NOXIOUS WEED/ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INFORMED THE COMMISSIONERS HIS ANNUAL NOTICE TO CONTROL NOXIOUS WEEDS IN THE COUNTY WILL BE PUBLISHED SOON; JESSE CAMPBELL, MIDWEST ALLIANCE, WILL BE BACK IN PRATT 3 DAYS THIS WEEK TO INSPECT WATER WELLS FOR RESIDENTS IN THE AREA WHO HAVE REQUESTED IT.

COMMISSIONER BORHO MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE JOINT CITY/COUNTY COMMISSIONER MEETING ON MARCH 6, 2017. CHAIRMAN WARD SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION CARRIED 2-0.

BLUE CROSS/BLUE SHIELD RATES FOR THE COUNTY WILL BE REDUCED BY 4.1% FOR CONTRACT YEAR JUNE 1, 2017 THRU MAY 31, 2018. COMMISSIONER BORHO MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE QUOTE FROM BLUE CROSS/BLUE SHIELD ON THE COUNTY'S HEALTH AND DENTAL INSURANCE STARTING JUNE 1, 2017. COMMISSIONER REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION CARRIED 3-0.

JIMMY WHITE, SHERIFF, DISCUSSED PROBLEMS GETTING INTO THE SALLY PORT WITH THE SHERIFF'S VAN; WATER LINE BROKE IN THE BASEMENT OF THE LEC; SHAWN HARDING HAS REVIEWED ISSUES IN THE JAIL CELLS AND WILL PROVIDE SPECS.

COMMISSIONER REYNOLDS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE PAYMENT VOUCHERS FOR MARCH 13, 2017. COMMISSIONER BORHO SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION CARRIED 3-0.
