

THE PRATT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MONDAY, AUGUST 24, 2020 AT 4:00 P.M. IN THE COMMISSIONER ROOM, 1ST FLOOR IN THE COURTHOUSE. WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: THOMAS W. JONES, GLENNA L. BORHO AND JOE R. REYNOLDS. TYSON EISENHAUER, COUNTY COUNSELOR AND LORI VOSS, COUNTY CLERK WERE ALSO PRESENT. ALSO PRESENT, MORGAN TRINKLE.

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

TYSON EISENHAUER, COUNTY COUNSELOR, REMINDED EVERYONE THE MEETING IS BEING STREAMED OVER ZOOM AND TO PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME WHEN SPEAKING; MARK GRABER, IT DIRECTOR, WILL WATCH FOR ANY COMMENTS OR QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC.

DOUG FREUND, ROAD SUPERVISOR, PRESENTED A QUOTE FROM INTEGREN SERVICES FOR REPAIRS TO THE FISH CLEANING STATION AT THE LAKE FOR \$5,695.00. COMMISSIONER BORHO MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE QUOTE FROM INTEGREN SERVICES FOR \$5,695.00 FOR REPAIRS TO THE FISH CLEANING STATION AT THE LAKE. COMMISSIONER REYNOLDS SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION CARRIED 3-0.

HEATHER MORGAN, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR, GAVE A SPARK UPDATE. RECOVERY TEAM CONTINUES TO MEET. PRATT COUNTY PLAN SUBMITTED AUGUST 5TH, 2020. ALL COUNTIES NOW HAVE TO BE APPROVED BEFORE ANY MONEY IS AWARDED. IT IS SUPPOSED TO BE APPROVED SEPTEMBER 15, 2020. BUSINESS GRANTS OPENED LAST WEDNESDAY AT NOON. THERE WERE 2000 APPLICATIONS WHEN IT OPENED. HEATHER AND DARCI VANDERVYVER, HEALTH DIRECTOR, ARE WORKING ON A CONTRACT FOR COVID-19 TEST KITS TO PURCHASE WHEN SPARK IS APPROVED.

DOUG FREUND, ROAD SUPERVISOR, REPORTED THE LIFT STATION AT THE LAKE IS NOT PUMPING FROM THE LAKE TO THE WILDLIFE AND PARKS. INTEGREN SERVICES DOES NOT HAVE A VACUUM TRUCK. ECK WILL COME OUT TUESDAY A.M. TO PUMP OUT. THE PUMPS ARE RUNNING, NOT SURE IF THEY ARE WORKING. HE IS STILL WAITING ON FEMA REIMBURSEMENT. HE REPORTED TWO ROAD GRADERS WERE DOWN FOR REPAIRS, ONE WAS INJECTORS AND HAS BEEN REPAIRED, THE OTHER HAD TO BE SENT TO WICHITA FOR REPAIRS.

SCOTT HARRIS, EMS DIRECTOR, REPORTED HE HAD HIS BOARD EMS INSPECTION, THE DEFICIENCIES IDENTIFIED WERE CORRECTED DURING THE INSPECTION PROCESS AND NO ADDITIONAL ACTIONS ARE NEEDED. HE IS LOOKING FOR A NEW MEDICAL ADVISOR, HE HAS BEEN NOTIFIED BY WAKON FOWLER MD THAT HE WISHES TO STEP DOWN AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

TRACEY PETZ, RSVP ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, PRESENTED CHECKS FOR SIGNATURES.

GARY BARKER AND TREY LANGFORD QUESTIONED THE ACRES WHERE THE PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING WILL BE, A MAP OF THE AREA WAS SHOWN TO THEM, THERE WILL BE 23.7 ACRES NOT PLANTED. COMMISSIONER BORHO REPORTED THE AREA WOULD BE STAKED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. TREY AND GARY QUESTIONED DIVERTING WATER SINCE THE TERRACES WILL BE PARTIALLY REMOVED. COMMISSIONER BORHO REPORTED THE CITY HAD MENTIONED A RETENTION WALL TO HELP WITH THE WATER COMING FROM THE SOLAR FARM. SHE RECOMMENDED THEY SPEAK TO THE CITY OFFICIALS ON IDEAS TO DIVERT WATER.

COUNTY CLERK, LORI VOSS, REPORTED THE STATE IS SENDING OUT BALLOT BOXES FOR SECURE BALLOT DROP OFFS. IT WAS DISCUSSED WHERE IT COULD BE LOCATED. IT WAS RECOMMENDED TO GET PRICES TO INSTALL.
