

COMMISSIONERS MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MONDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2020 AT 4:00 P.M. IN THE COMMISSIONER ROOM, 1ST FLOOR IN THE COURTHOUSE. WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: THOMAS W. JONES, GLENNA L. BORHO AND JOE R. REYNOLDS. TYSON EISENHAUER, COUNTY COUNSELOR, LORI VOSS, COUNTY CLERK AND MARK GRABER, IT DIRECTOR, WERE ALSO PRESENT.

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

TYSON EISENHAUER, COUNTY COUNSELOR, REMINDED EVERYONE THE MEETING IS BEING STREAMED OVER ZOOM AND TO PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME WHEN SPEAKING; MARK GRABER, IT DIRECTOR, WILL WATCH FOR ANY COMMENTS OR QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC.

DARCIE VAN DERYVER, HEALTH DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR, REPORTED THERE ARE 7 ACTIVE CASES IN PRATT COUNTY. SHE IS IN THE PROCESS OF SETTING UP A DASHBOARD WHERE INFORMATION CAN BE INPUTED, IT WILL SHOW GRAPHS AND INCLUDE ALL DATA. SHE RECEIVED A GRANT FROM SOUTH CENTRAL COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR \$1,080 AND IS WANTING TO PURCHASE SMART THERMOMETERS. SHE REPORTED SHE HAS REPORTS DUE FOR THE 1ST QUARTER. SHE REPORTED SHE HAD CONTACTED TIFFANY AILSTOCK, RSVP DIRECTOR, ABOUT THE HERMES HEALTHCARE FOOT CARE CLINICS. THEY COME TWICE A MONTH EVERY OTHER MONTH. THEY SEE 50 PATIENTS PER VISIT AND ALL CLAIMS ARE TURNED INTO MEDICARE. TIFFANY REPORTED IT GOES VERY WELL EVERY TIME.

DOUG FREUND, ROAD SUPERVISOR, PRESENTED A ROAD CROSSING FOR IDEATEK TELCOM, LLC FOR INSTALLING FIBER OPTIC NETWORK SOUTH OF CULLISON, RUNNING PARALLEL TO SW 90TH AVENUE, CROSSING UNDER SW 20TH STREET.

JASON WINKEL, LANDFILL/RECYCLING SUPERVISOR, REPORTED CAT CAME OUT TO SERVICE THE LOADER AT THE LANDFILL. THEY ADJUSTED VALVES, DRILLED OUT AND TOOK OFF INJECTORS, REPLACED INJECTORS, WOULDN'T START, THEY FOUND MORE WRONG WITH THE VALVES, IT IS NOW IN WICHITA FOR REPAIRS, PRATT COUNTY WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BILL. HE IS TRYING TO GET RID OF PLASTICS AT THE RECYCLING CENTER, METAL PRICES ARE UP AND PAPER STILL SHIPPING OUT.

ALL THE PPE HE HAS ORDERED HAS BEEN DELIVERED.
