**POSITIVE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) CASE NO. 13 and 14 IDENTIFIED IN PRATT COUNTY RESIDENTS on 7/9/2020**

The cases involve two female individuals. The cases are not connected. One of the individuals is experiencing symptoms, the other is not. Both individuals are following the quarantine guidelines. The Pratt County Health Department is still actively performing patient contact tracing to determine a source and to inquire who the individuals may have had contact with during their contagious period. All individuals who may have been at risk of exposure are notified as soon as possible. No additional information about the individuals will be released at this time.

If you are notified by the Health Department of being a contact of someone who tested positive for COVID-19, you **MUST** quarantine at home for 14 days. A negative test will not return an exposed person to work/school/sports/daycare/etc. sooner than 14 days.

We continue to strongly encourage everyone to practice good hygiene by frequently washing your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or more, disinfect high touch areas often, practice social distancing, and wear a mask when social distancing cannot be maintained.
