ACCESSIBILITY OF SARA
TITLE II HAZARDOUS
SUBSTANCE INFORMATION

Section 324 of the Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act, also known as SARA Title III (Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, PL-99-499) requires public notice at least once annually informing the public of the means to access information about extremely hazardous substances that are manufactured, stored and used within their community. Follow-up emergency notices may subsequently be issued.

Accordingly, Information concerning LEPC meetings, SARA Title III hazardous materials planning which is included in our Pratt County Emergency Operations Response Plan, materials safety data sheets (MSDS), hazardous chemical inventory forms, listing extremely hazardous substances manufactured, stored or used within Pratt County can be obtained during normal business hours by contacting Pratt County LEPC at 1001 E. 1st in Pratt.
